Ken Tamai Memorial Judo Championships – The Ken Tamai Memorial Judo Championships was held on October 18th at Beltsville Academic Center. Hui-O hosts this event every spring and fall in

Many of the club members and thier families helped with set up of mats, running the scoring tables, running the concession stand, tournament operations, and so much more. Congratulations to Sensei Brad and Charlie who won first place in the Nage No Kata competition. Sensei Mark and Christian Beirtumpfel won second, then switched roles and won third in the Nage No Kata competition.

Luke won his first match against Taylor Byrd from Washington Judo by an Ippon, He lost his second match to Dan Goldeen from Shin Jo in Charlottesville, He lost his third match to Thuc Tran from Phan University and he won his final match against Ben Atkins from Washington Judo by an Ippon.

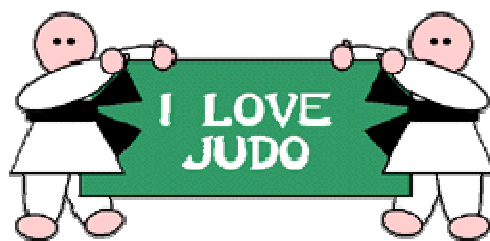
After working all morning as a technical official running the clocks for the junior divisions, Rob Guthero won THIRD place in a five man round robin pool. He got a bye in the first round, in the second round he lost to Brandon Shapiro from Sport Judo, in the third round he defeated Dan Goldeen, an Ikkyu from SSAL Shin Jo in Charlottesville, VA with an Ippon, in the fourth round he scored another Ippon against Yun Kim from Southern Maryland Jujitsu. He lost his final match.

Josh Vaughn won SECOND place in his five man round robin division. He defeated Shane Stringfellow from Yama Arashi, by an Ippon. He got a bye in the second round. He lost the third round to Brandon Shipiro from Sport Judo. He won the fourth round against Aaron Farley from Cavalier Judo in Charlottesville by an Ippon. And he won the fifth round he scored an Ippon against James Suberling from Budokan from Dunkirk Maryland.



Navy Team Tourney- On October 4, at the US Naval Academy in Annapolis, MD, we had a full team representing Hui-O-Judo. Our team consisted of Lisa Capriotti, Josh Vaughn, Robert Guthro, Omar Torres, Galen Jones, Robert Kirk and Sensei Brad. There were 8 teams: One from USNA, two from Georgetown, two from Philadelphia, one from Charlottesville, and one pickup team. Sensei Brad played on the pickup team to keep the rest of the club together. The teams were divided into 5 and 3 to compete for different trophies. Hui-O-Judo was in the group of 5 and was eliminated after 2 losses. Georgetown once again won both cups.

Maryland State Judo Championships -On Saturday, November 1st the Maryland Open will be held. The Maryland Open is an open tournament for all junior and senior Judoka from all states. This tournament is the qualifier, for Maryland Judo Players, for the USJI Senior Nationals, USJI Junior Olympics and USJI Junior U. S. Open. To be eligible you must be a current member of USJI, USJF or USJA. Membership in USJI or USJF may be obtained during registration. Kata Registration will be from 8:30 to 9:30 am. Junior Shiai Registration and Weigh-in will be from 8:00 to 10:00 am. Senior Shiai Registration and Weigh-in will be from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon. Shufu Promotionals – WE NEED YOUR HELP!! Hui-O will be hosting the Shufu Judo Yudanshakai Junior and Senior Promotional Examination and Shiai. The Shufu Junior Promotional will be on Saturday, November 15th. The Shufu Senior Promotional will be on Sunday, November 16th. It is a very labor intensive event over two long days. We need as many people who can volunteer to help as possible. We need help in all areas of event administration and operations. We need lots of people to help with registration, data entry, concessions, technical operations, general logistics and much more. Registration both days will be from 8:30 to 9:00 am. A valid membership in USJF, USJI or USJA is required of each participant. Your current card must be shown at registration the morning of the event. All participants must be listed on the “Judoka recommended for promotion” form that is submitted by each club Sensei. Only judoka listed on the form with ALL required documentation will be considered for promotion. Only USJF members will be promoted. USJA and USJI members may request to be examined and have their results, from their participation, forwarded to the appropriate organization for consideration for promotion. The deadline for paperwork is November 7th so make sure your paperwork is filled out and returned to your Sensei by November 4th.

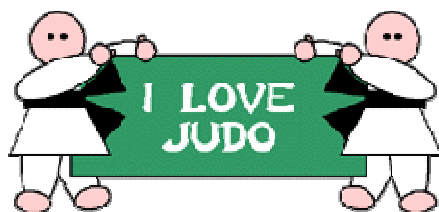

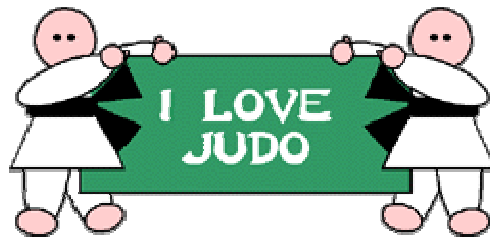
