Eligibility to compete: A current USJI, USJF, or USJA membership card **MUST** be presented at registration along with the **LIABILITY WAIVER** and **ENTRY FEE**. There will be no refunds of the entry fee.

Contest Rules: Current IJF contest rules will govern **EXCEPT** no chokes or arm locks for 12 years old and younger. No arm locks for ages 13 to 16 years old. Any judoka under the age of 16 who wishes to compete in the Senior division will compete with no exceptions to the IJF rules. Anyone competing up in rank divisions will be subject to the rules for that group. Any attempt to perform any technique with the intent to injure the opponent as determined by the officials on the mat will be an automatic hansoku make.

Notes: Female competitors are **REQUIRED** to wear a plain white tee shirt. All competitors should have two gi's, one blue and one white. If you only have a white gi, then you should have a blue belt and a white belt of your own. You can not come with only a blue gi.

Elimination System: Round Robin for small divisions. Larger divisions will use a modified Double elimination System will be used. The winner of the winners pool shall get first place, the winner of the loser pool shall get second place and the loser of the final match in the loser pool shall get third place. For divisions with fewer than 5 contestants, a round robin point system will be used.
